Overview of Travel and Objectives

The Federal, Provincial and Territorial Ministers responsible for Infrastructure met to discuss progress and lessons learned on the implementation of Phase I of the Government of Canada's infrastructure plan. Ministers then had the opportunity to discuss the long-term Investing in Canada Plan and federal funding announced in Budget 2017 including the signing of Integrated Bilateral Agreements.

Provincial and Territorial Ministers presented Infrastructure Canada with a set of principles to guide the development of Phase II of the Investing in Canada Plan. The principles built upon statements agreed to by all Premiers at the June 2017 Council of the Federation meeting.
