Overview of Travel and Objectives

Attend Federal-Provincial-Territorial Ministers of Immigration meeting. The meeting included the following discussions: a new multi-year plan for immigration levels in Canada; changes to the federal Express Entry system; settlement and integration of newcomers (including refugees); and foreign qualification recognition. Met with the new Federal ministers and officials to present and advocate for the Government of Saskatchewan's positions on various matters.

Attendance at two separate meetings in Quebec City regarding inter-governmental collaboration on labour market issues:

- Provincial-Territorial Labour Market Ministers (October 13, 2016);
- Federal-Provincial-Territorial Forum of Labour Market Ministers (FLMM, October 14, 2016).

Met regarding a number of items that align with priorities for the Government of Saskatchewan: renewal of labour market transfers; the Temporary Foreign Worker Program; and an update on the launch of the Labour Market Information Council for Canada.
