

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

April 2016

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering April 10th to 16th, 2016, there were 560,100 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is an increase of 900 from March 2016 but 9,400 less than the number employed in April 2015.

Agricultural employment was 39,800 persons in April 2016, down 400 from the March 2016 level and 1,200 less than the April 2015 agricultural employment level of 41,000. Non-agricultural employment was 520,300 persons in April 2016. This is an increase of 1,300 from the March 2016 non-agriculture employment level of 519,000 but 8,200 less than April 2015.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for April 2016 was 7.0 percent. This is an increase of 0.1 percentage points from the March 2016 rate of 6.9 percent and 2.2 percentage points higher than the April 2015 level of 4.8 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force increased by 1,800 to 602,500 persons in April 2016 from 600,700 persons in March 2016. This is 4,500 more than the April 2015 labour force of 598,000 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate rose 0.2 percentage points to 69.5 percent in April 2016 from 69.3 percent in March 2016. The April 2015 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 69.6 percent.

There were 42,400 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during April 2016. This is an increase of 800 from March 2016 and is 13,900 more than the number unemployed in April 2015.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 566,700 persons employed in Saskatchewan in April 2016, down 1,600 from the March 2016 level of 568,300 and down 9,200 from the April 2015 employment level of 575,900 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for April 2016 was 6.3 percent. This is an increase of 0.1 percentage points from the March 2016 rate of 6.2 percent and 1.9 percentage points higher than the April 2015 rate of 4.4 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment increased by 97,600 persons in April 2016 to 17,824,200 persons from 17,726,600 persons in March 2016. In April 2015, there were 17,697,900 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate decreased 0.2 percentage points in April 2016 to 7.5 percent from the March 2016 level of 7.7 percent. In April 2015, Canada's unemployment rate was 7.1 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 7.1 percent in April 2016. This remained unchanged from March 2016 and 0.3 percentage points higher than the April 2015 level of 6.8 percent.
