

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

August 2016

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering August 14th to 20th, 2016, there were 574,700 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is a decrease of 1,400 from July 2016 and 4,000 less than the number employed in August 2015.

Agricultural employment was 44,900 persons in August 2016, up 2,200 from the July 2016 level and 2,900 more than the August 2015 agricultural employment level of 42,000. Non-agricultural employment was 529,800 persons in August 2016. This is a decrease of 3,600 from the July 2016 non-agriculture employment level of 533,400 and 6,900 less than August 2015.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for August 2016 was 6.8 percent. This is an increase 0.5 percentage points from the July 2016 rate of 6.3 percent and 0.8 percentage points higher than the August 2015 level of 6.0 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force increased by 1,800 to 616,600 persons in August 2016 from 614,800 persons in July 2016. This is 1,100 more than the August 2015 labour force of 615.5 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate rose 0.1 percentage points to 70.8 percent in August 2016 from 70.7 percent in July 2016. The August 2015 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 71.3 percent.

There were 42,000 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during August 2016. This is an increase of 3,400 from July 2016 and 5,200 more than the number unemployed in August 2015.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 569,000 persons employed in Saskatchewan in August 2016, down 400 from the July 2016 level of 569,400 and is down 4,500 from the August 2015 employment level of 573,500 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for August 2016 was 6.3 percent. This is remained unchanged from the July 2016 rate of 6.3 percent and 1.5 percentage points higher than the August 2015 rate of 4.8 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment decreased by 5,000 persons in August 2016 to 18,296,600 persons from 18,301,600 persons in July 2016. In August 2015, there were 18,228,800 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate increased 0.4 percentage points in August 2016 to 7.6 percent from the July 2016 level of 7.2 percent. In August 2015, Canada's unemployment rate was 7.5 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 7.0 percent in August 2016. This is 0.1 percentage points higher than July 2016 and remained unchanged from the August 2015 level of 7.0.
