

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

December 2014

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering December 7th to 13th, 2014, there were 567,700 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is an increase of 100 from November 2014 and 14,000 more than the number employed in December 2013.

Agricultural employment was 41,400 persons in December 2014, down 800 from the November 2014 level and 700 less than the December 2013 agricultural employment level of 42,100. Non-agricultural employment was 526,300 persons in December 2014. This is an increase of 900 from the November 2014 non-agriculture employment level of 525,400 and 14,700 more than December 2013.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for December 2014 was 3.3 percent. This is an increase of 0.1 percentage points from the November 2014 rate of 3.2 percent but 0.2 percentage points lower than the December 2013 level of 3.5 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force increased by 900 to 587,100 persons in December 2014 from 586,200 persons in November 2014. This is 13,200 more than the December 2013 labour force of 573,900 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate was unchanged at 69.2 percentage in December 2014 compared to November 2014. The December 2013 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 68.8 percent.

There were 19,400 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during December 2014. This is an increase of 800 from November 2014 but is 700 less than the number unemployed in December 2013.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 572,800 persons employed in Saskatchewan in December 2014, up 700 from the November 2014 level of 572,100 and is up 14,800 from the December 2013 employment level of 558,800 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for December 2014 was 3.6 percent. This is an increase of 0.2 percentage points from the November 2014 rate of 3.4 percent and 0.3 percentage points lower than the December 2013 rate of 3.9 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment decreased by 89,800 persons in December 2014 to 17,871,900 persons from 17,961,700 persons in November 2014. In December 2013, there were 17,681,500 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate decreased 0.1 percentage points in December 2014 to 6.1 percent from the November 2014 level of 6.2 percent. In December 2013, Canada's unemployment rate was 6.7 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 6.6 percent in December 2014. This is the same as November 2014 but 0.6 percentage points lower than the December 2013 level of 7.2 percent.
