Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

December 2012

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey for the week ended December 8, 2012, there were 539,800 persons <u>employed</u> in Saskatchewan during December 2012, a decrease of 200 from November 2012 but 16,300 more than the number employed in December 2011.

Agricultural employment was 40,200 persons in December 2012, down 600 from the November 2012 level but 4,500 more than the December 2011 agricultural employment level of 35,700. Non-agricultural employment was 499,600 persons in December 2012. This is an increase of 400 from the November 2012 non-agriculture employment level of 499,200 and 11,800 more than December 2011.

The Saskatchewan <u>unemployment rate</u> for December 2012 was 4.3 percent. This is an increase of 0.3 percentage points from the November 2012 rate of 4.0 percent but 0.4 percentage points lower than the December 2011 level of 4.7 percent.

Saskatchewan's <u>labour force</u> increased by 1,300 to 564,000 persons in December 2012 from 562,700 persons in November 2012. This is 14,400 more than the December 2011 labour force of 549,600 persons.

The Saskatchewan <u>participation rate</u> rose 0.1 percentage points to 69.0 percent in December 2012 from 68.9 percent in November 2012. The December 2011 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 68.3 percent.

There were 24,200 persons <u>unemployed</u> in Saskatchewan during December 2012. This is an increase of 1,600 from November 2012 but is 1,900 less than the number unemployed in December 2011.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a <u>seasonally adjusted</u> basis there were 544,400 persons <u>employed</u> in Saskatchewan in December 2012, up 4,000 from the November 2012 level of 540,400 and up 16,400 from the December 2011 employment level of 528,000 persons.

The Saskatchewan <u>seasonally adjusted</u> <u>unemployment rate</u> for December 2012 was 4.6 percent. This is an increase of 0.1 percentage points from the November 2012 rate of 4.5 percent but 0.6 percentage points lower than the December 2011 rate of 5.2 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian <u>employment</u> decreased by 31,600 persons in December 2012 to 17,574,000 persons from 17,605,600 persons in November 2012. In December 2011, there were 17,271,700 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's <u>unemployment rate</u> decreased 0.2 percentage points in December 2012 to 6.5 percent from the November 2012 level of 6.7 percent. In December 2011, Canada's unemployment rate was 6.9 percent.

The <u>seasonally adjusted</u> unemployment rate for Canada was 7.1 percent in December 2012. This is 0.1 percentage points lower than November 2012 and 0.4 percentage points lower than the December 2011 level of 7.5 percent.
