

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

August 2010

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey for the week ended August 21, 2010, there were 535,200 persons employed in Saskatchewan during August 2010, an increase of 3,100 from July 2010 and 13,800 more than the number employed in August 2009.

Agricultural employment was 44,100 persons in August 2010, up 200 from the July 2010 level but 400 less than the August 2009 agricultural employment level of 44,500. Non-agricultural employment was 491,100 persons in August 2010. This is an increase of 2,900 from the July 2010 non-agriculture employment level of 488,200 and 14,200 more than August 2009.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for August 2010 was 5.7 percent. This is an increase of 0.3 percentage points from the July 2010 rate of 5.4 percent but 0.4 percentage points lower than the August 2009 level of 6.1 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force increased by 4,900 to 567,600 persons in August 2010 from 562,700 persons in July 2010. This is 12,500 more than the August 2009 labour force of 555,100 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate rose 0.5 percentage points to 71.5 percent in August 2010 from 71.0 percent in July 2010. The August 2009 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 71.1 percent.

There were 32,400 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during August 2010. This is an increase of 1,800 from July 2010 but is 1,300 less than the number unemployed in August 2009.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 531,400 persons employed in Saskatchewan in August 2010, unchanged from the July 2010 level of 531,400 and is 12,700 up from the August 2009 employment level of 518,700 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for August 2010 was 4.8 percent. This is a decrease of 0.3 percentage points from the July 2010 rate of 5.1 percent and 0.1 percentage points lower than the August 2009 rate of 4.9 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment decreased by 7,800 persons in August 2010 to 17,446,500 persons from 17,454,300 persons in July 2010. In August 2009, there were 17,080,400 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate increased 0.4 percentage points to 8.7 percent from the July 2010 level of 8.3 percent. In August 2009, Canada's unemployment rate was 9.0 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 8.1 percent in August 2010. This is 0.1 percentage points higher than July 2010 but 0.6 percentage points lower than the August 2009 level of 8.7 percent.
