

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

October 2010

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey for the week ended October 16, 2010, there were 525,800 persons employed in Saskatchewan during October 2010, a decrease of 2,300 from September 2010 but 5,200 more than the number employed in October 2009.

Agricultural employment was 44,000 persons in October 2010, up 1,700 from the September 2010 level but 2,700 less than the October 2009 agricultural employment level of 46,700. Non-agricultural employment was 481,800 persons in October 2010. This is a decrease of 4,000 from the September 2010 non-agriculture employment level of 485,800 but 7,900 more than October 2009.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for October 2010 was 5.1 percent. This is an increase of 0.2 percentage points from the September 2010 rate of 4.9 percent and 0.7 percentage points higher than the October 2009 level of 4.4 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force decreased by 900 to 554,400 persons in October 2010 from 555,300 persons in September 2010. This is 9,700 more than the October 2009 labour force of 544,700 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate fell 0.1 percentage points to 69.8 percent in October 2010 from 69.9 percent in September 2010. The October 2009 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 69.6 percent.

There were 28,500 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during October 2010. This is an increase of 1,300 from September 2010 and is 4,400 more than the number unemployed in October 2009.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 525,800 persons employed in Saskatchewan in October 2010, down 1,000 from the September 2010 level of 526,800 but is up 6,000 from the October 2009 employment level of 519,800 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for October 2010 was 5.7 percent. This is an increase of 0.2 percentage points from the September 2010 rate of 5.5 percent and 0.6 percentage points higher than the October 2009 rate of 5.1 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment increased by 36,800 persons in October 2010 to 17,285,200 persons from 17,248,400 persons in September 2010. In October 2009, there were 16,909,400 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate decreased 0.2 percentage points to 7.2 percent from the September 2010 level of 7.4 percent. In October 2009, Canada's unemployment rate 7.6 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 7.9 percent in October 2010. This is 0.1 percentage points lower than September 2010 and 0.5 percentage points lower than the October 2009 level of 8.4 percent.
