

Farm Stewardship Program

Used Oil Storage BMP

Intent of BMP: To assist producers with the storage of used oil through the purchase of appropriate storage tanks. Proper storage of used oil can help prevent oil and other toxic contents from contaminating soils and entering surface waters. Storage designed for this purpose can also improve farm safety and make the recycling of these wastes more convenient.

Funding Level: 50 per cent of eligible costs to a maximum of \$2,000.

Application Type: **Rebate.**

Eligibility:

- Must have an EFP.
- **Basic Eligibility Criteria.**

Project Requirements: The applicant is responsible for selecting the location of the used oil storage project and for meeting all regulatory requirements. The distance to the nearest water body must be a minimum 30 metres. The requirement of a commercial recycler to pick up the oil or a municipal recycle centre to receive the used oil should be considered.

Project Costs: Eligible Costs

- Double wall steel storage tank designed for the temporary storage of used oil.
- Eligible tanks must have a ULC approved stamp or plate indicating it is for the purpose stated above (ULC-652).

Ineligible Costs

- Costs for projects started prior to April 1, 2015.
- Stationary or portable fuel tanks, or catch trays for oil or gas.
- Handling or disposal of used oil, filters, and fluid and containers.
- Pumps, set-up and venting.
- Any tank not labelled or stamped ULC-652.
