No Surface Disturbance/Cancelled Wells on IRIS

The Government of Saskatchewan is no longer automatically applying the \$5,100 Reclamation Liability to wells with cancelled status as of September 28, 2017.

The Exemption from Reclamation(No Surface Disturbance) application

All Cancelled wells and facilities that have Surface Disturbance, other than a land survey, must be disclosed to PNG.support@gov.sk.ca ; at that time a \$5,100 reclamation liability will be applied and an Acknowledgement of Reclamation application will be required to remove the liability.
