About

This release implemented 44 items, including the ability for industry to generate and download their Business Associate's (BA) *Resource Surcharge Working Interest Owner (WIO) Detail Report* on-demand through IRIS.

What's changed?

The highlights of what's changed in IRIS as a result of this release are noted below.

Note: Whether a user has access to the functionality or enhancements outlined in these *Release Notes* depends on the individual's security access and assigned permissions sets.

Petroleum Tenure Module

- The legal land description's (LLD) compents are now separated into individual columns in the preliminary and final lease continuance CSV reports.
- Users can print lease continuance reports one disposition at a time to share with working interest owners.
- Preliminary lease continuance reports now display when the next review date will take place for leases with a continuing reason of extended (EX) or primary term (PT).

Well and Facility Infrastructure Functionality

- Well licence applicants can now identify if the well is part of a PAD, which will assist in speeding up the review process. See the IRIS Industry Tip [PAD Well Set Coming to Well Licence Applications](#), published on www.saskatchewan.ca/IRIS on September 22 for more information.
- A new information field was added to the Maximum Well Head Injection Pressure Report (MWHIP) obligation screen to inform the BA of what needs to be completed in order to fulfill the obligation:

In order to fulfill the obligation, the user must attach a MWHIP report as well as enter the MWHIP pressure value with the well completion. The MWHIP also appears on the well completions screen for all injection wells.

- Fixed an issue where the log obligation screen took the user to the markers screen rather than the log screen when attempting to complete the data to fulfill the obligation.

Invoice Module

- Users can run their *BA Resource Surcharge WIO Detail Report* on-demand. This functionality enables a BA to verify their resource surcharge calculation.
