

POLICY ON THE RELEASE OF MARS INFORMATION RELATED TO DISPOSITIONS

It is the policy of the Lands and Mineral Tenure (LMT) Branch, upon request from a client, to only provide information from the MARS system that does not result in a breach of third party confidentiality. The client will be required to call the MARS Help Desk (306-787-9030) or email at mars@gov.sk.ca to request information. The MARS Help Desk will advise the client as to whether the information can be provided or not, based on this policy.

Clients can have access to: names of holders of dispositions, automated emails from MARS, the Search book, and the Mineral Disposition Map. If automated emails pertain to a disposition that the client does NOT own, then client only has access to what is found in Search Book and through the Mineral Disposition Map.

LMT will not release: third party financial information as defined in MARS (Work Credit History in MARS), any information that would be considered a breach of third party confidentiality (correspondence - which is not the subject of this policy - and Work Credit History), large data extractions, nor business information where industry reasonably expects that LMT keep the information confidential.

MARS does not provide access to expenditure reports to clients that are not holders or agents of holders of the dispositions. Ministry staff will not perform large data extractions for clients, and will not create any items that do not already exist.
