Saskatchewan is investing in infrastructure for a growing province. Saskatchewan's 2018-19 Budget includes \$2.7 billion for investment in infrastructure projects, ranging from expanding power generation assets to telecommunications networks, water systems, schools and highways.

The forum will provide an opportunity to learn more about the major infrastructure plans around information technology, construction, engineering and manufacturing services of Saskatchewan Crown corporations and ministries. There will also be a chance to network and to learn "how to do business" with the Crowns and ministries.
