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### Shadow Billing EXTENDED for IRIS Non-compliance Penalty Assessment Program Until June 30, 2017:

The Government of Saskatchewan is pleased with the overall results of the IRIS non-compliance penalty assessment program for unfulfilled well data submission obligations. During the latest shadow billing period, a number of issues related to IRIS obligations have been identified. These issues will be corrected and implemented as soon as possible, but may take a few IRIS release cycles to complete. To allow time for those corrections, the Government of Saskatchewan is extending the shadow-billing period for IRIS non-compliance penalty assessment related to unfulfilled well data submission obligations until **June 30, 2017**.

### Non-compliance Invoicing

The July 2017 invoice will be an actual and payable invoice that will be issued during the first week of July. Unfulfilled IRIS obligations that are over-due as of the end of June 2017 will be invoiced in July 2017. Penalties will be applied to all unfulfilled over-due obligations from the obligation's due date to the end of June 2017.
