Notice of Pending Cancellation of Dispositions Issued



On January 11, 2017, the Ministry of the Economy (ECON) issued pending cancellation notices directly to lessees and/or Confidential Designated Representatives of Crown dispositions. These notices inform holders if they do not take action or commence to take action to meet their obligations within 60 days, their disposition may be cancelled.

Organizations with working interests in dispositions are encouraged to visit IRIS to ensure dispositions they have a stake in are not pending cancellation.

To search for dispositions:


- 1. Log into IRIS.
- 2. Click 'Dispositions' under the 'Quick Search' tab on IRIS's main page.
- 3. Enter the relevant parameters into the search fields. Be sure to select 'Pending Cancellation' from the 'Disposition Status Qualifier' drop down menu.




4. Click 'Search.'

To generate a disposition report:

- 1. Log into IRIS.
- 2. Click 'Reports' on IRIS's main menu. From there, select Tenure Dispositions, then 'Disposition Inventory' under 'Administration'.



 In the 'Disposition Inventory Report' screen, enter the required information (denoted by *). Select 'Pending Cancellation' from the 'Disposition Status Qualifier Type' drop down menu.



4. Click 'View Report'.
