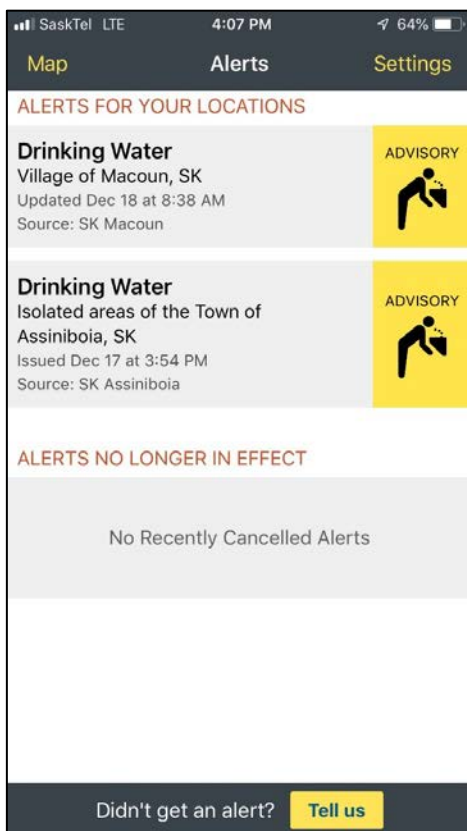


How to Download & Set the SaskAlert App

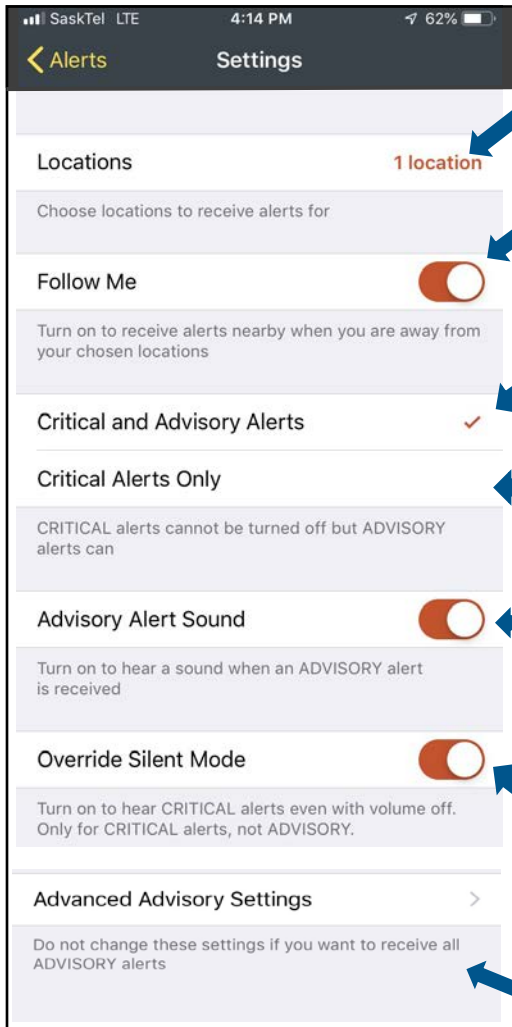
1. To find and download the app from the app store search by the following:
 - Saskalert
 - Emergency Alerts
 - Saskatchewan Emergency Alerts
2. When you open the app for the first time, you will be asked “to allow for notifications from SaskAlert”. Select “yes”.
 - a. If you do not select “yes”, then you will not receive alerts.
 - b. If you made a mistake and selected “no”, you can switch it to “yes” under the notifications tool in your phone’s settings.
3. You will then be taken to the main screen of the SaskAlert app (shown below). Your first step should be to set up your settings.

Main Screen



By default, when you first download the app the **settings** will be to receive no alerts for any locations. You can refine your setting by accessing the **settings screen** by touching **settings**.

Choose "Locations" to take you to the next screen in order to select the whole province or individual areas.

Switching "Follow Me" to **ON** will allow you to receive alerts nearby when you are away from your chosen locations.

When the app is downloaded, you will receive Critical and Emergency Advisory alerts by default. This selection is shown by a checkmark beside "Critical and Advisory Alerts".

If you only want to receive critical alerts, click on "Critical Alerts Only" and the checkmark will appear beside it.

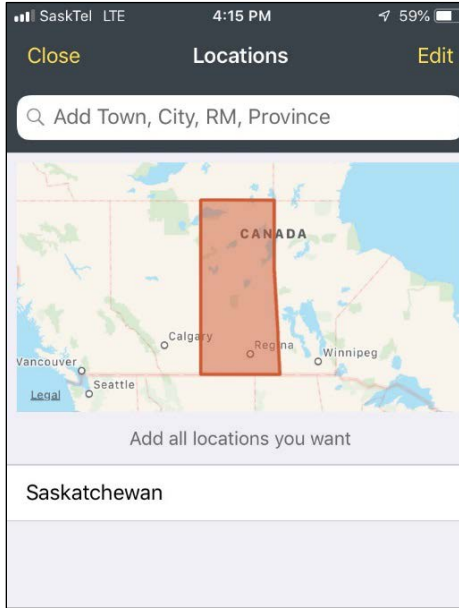
If you choose to receive emergency advisory alerts, you have the option of deciding if you want to hear an advisory tone or no tone when one is received. Turn this to **ON** in order to receive the advisory tone.

Critical Alerts will sound regardless of what you have chosen here.

Turn the "Override Silent Mode" to **ON** in order to receive the Critical Alert tone even when your phone is on vibrate or Do Not Disturb.

Click on "Advanced Advisory Settings" if you want to receive advisory alerts for certain events. If you want to receive ALL advisory alerts, then leave this as is.

Location Settings Screen



Enter the name of the community that you would like to have in your settings. Enter **Saskatchewan** to receive notifications for the whole province. Other examples:

Biggar:

Enter Biggar to have the option to select Biggar No. 347 for the RM of Biggar or Biggar, SK for the town.

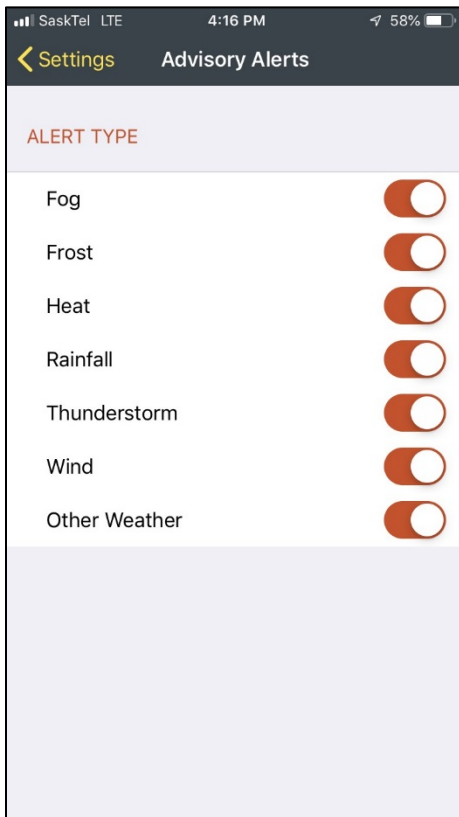
Ministikwan First Nation:

Enter Ministikwan to have the option to select Ministikwan 161 or Ministikwan 161A.

Moose Jaw:

Enter Moose Jaw to have the option to select Moose Jaw No. 161 for the RM of Moose Jaw or Moose Jaw, SK for the city.

Advanced Settings Screen

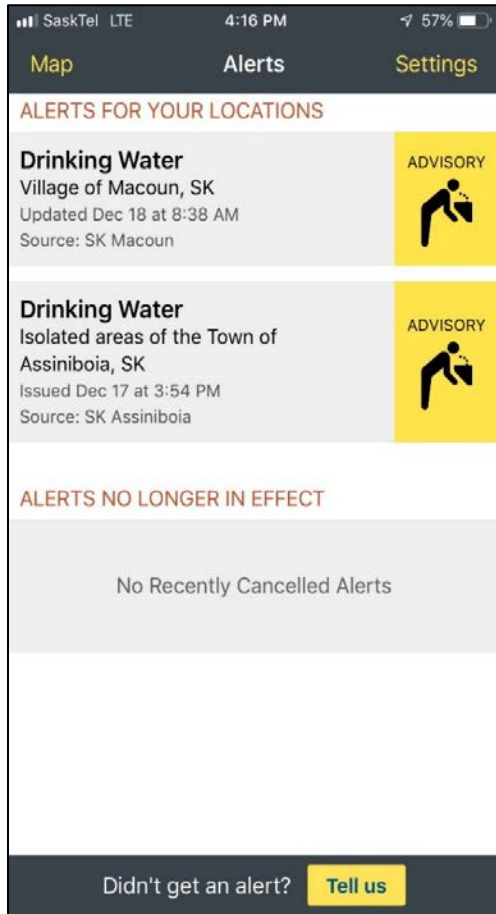


If you want to receive all of these advisory alerts types, then leave them all turned to **ON**.

NOTE: Once you download the app and agree to notifications, you **WILL** receive all critical alerts. There is no option to turn off Critical alerts the way that Emergency Advisory Alerts can be turned off.

Once you have your settings screen completed touch the word **Alert** at the top left of the screen to go back to the **Emergency Alerts Screen**.

App Main Screen



Alerts will display for any active alerts for the locations you have selected.

Alerts are grouped into the following categories, with most recent alert displayed first in each category:

- **Critical Alerts** appear at the top of the screen with a red icon.
- **Emergency Advisory Alerts** are identified second with a yellow icon.
- **Broadcast Test Alerts** will also appear on this screen with a green icon.

All cancelled alerts will display in this area for 24 hours.

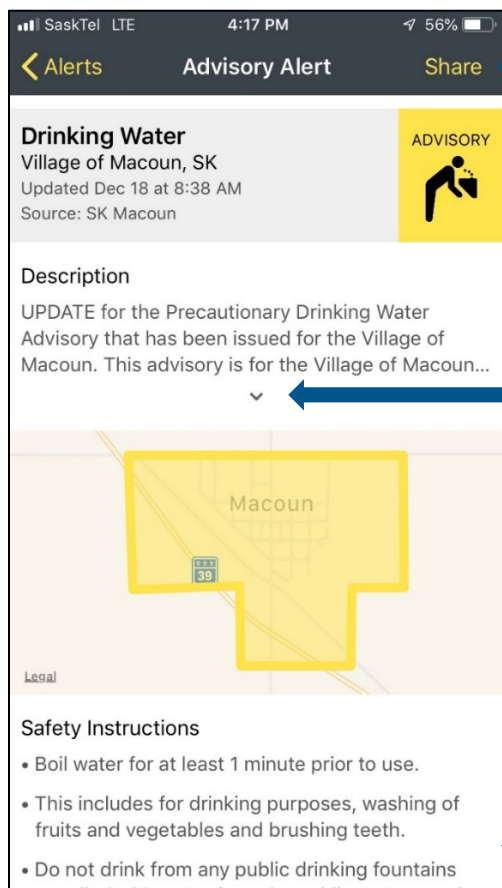
If you did not receive an alert, click on the "Tell us" button and enter the information about the alert you were missing.

Your information will be sent to SaskAlert; someone will respond to you with a follow-up email.

Touching any of the listed alerts, will take you to the "details" screen of that alert, shown on the next page.

App Alert Detail Screen

On the main screen you can go into the details of a specific alert.



Touching the share icon in the top Navigation Bar on the details screen for any alert will cause an action sheet to rise from the bottom of the screen exposing sharing options such as *message* and *mail* so you can forward the alert to another person.

If the alert's description exceeds four lines, a "down arrow" will appear. Touch the "down arrow" to see all of the alert's description.

You can zoom and pan the map through touch:

- Zoom in/out by performing a pinch-pull action.
- Pan left/right by touching the map and moving your finger left or right.

App Updates

In order to receive alerts properly, both your phone's software and the SaskAlert App software must be updated with the most current version available.

When a SaskAlert App update is available, it will display in the App store under the "Updates" tab.
