## **Introduction**

On August 23, 2005, the Canada-Saskatchewan Agreement on the Transfer of Federal Gas Tax Revenues 2005 – 2015 (Gas Tax Agreement) was signed. Under the ten year Gas Tax Agreement, Saskatchewan municipalities receive federal funding for environmentally sustainable infrastructure investments.

On March 31, 2006, the Canada-Saskatchewan Agreement on the Transfer of Funds for Public Transit 2005 - 2010 (Public Transit Agreement) was signed. In September 2006, the federal government provided additional public transit funding through the establishment of a Public Transit Capital Trust Arrangement (Trust). Federal funding under the Public Transit Agreement and Trust assists Saskatchewan cities in supporting their capital investments in public transit infrastructure.

This Annual Report of the Gas Tax and Public Transit Programs is prepared by the New Deal Secretariat, as required under the respective agreements. It reports on the programs' activities for the period of April 1, 2007 to March 31, 2008.

## **Saskatchewan's Commitments & Contributions**

During 2007-08 Saskatchewan made the following progress with respect to its commitments and contributions identified in section 3.2 of the Gas Tax Agreement and section 4.2 of the Public Transit Agreement:

- Administration
  - The New Deal Secretariat continues to administer the Gas Tax Program and the Public Transit Agreement and Trust, consistent with the federally approved business case;
  - With respect to the Gas Tax Program, the Secretariat expects to administer an estimated 1,500 municipal Infrastructure Investment Plans (IIPs), 767 Municipal Funding Agreements and 6,900 payments to be made over the first five years of the program; and

- The federal-provincial-municipal New Deal Partnership Committee (Committee), with a mandate to oversee the implementation of the agreements and develop further areas agreed to:
  - Amend the Agreement on the Transfer of Federal Gas Tax Revenues under the New Deal for Cities and Communities to:
    - Include the Flin Flon Boundary Area in the Agreement;
    - Revise the reporting timeline for Saskatchewan to accommodate the existing municipal financial reporting timelines;
    - Review the regional requirement for municipalities; and
    - Review the spending options regarding interest earned on funds.
  - Adhere to the March 31, 2008 deadline for municipalities to submit their first Infrastructure Investment Plan.
- Municipal Funding Agreements
  - As of March 31, 2008, Municipal Funding Agreements, which include the municipal requirements set out in the respective agreements, were in place with 499 municipalities under the Gas Tax program and 9 municipalities under the Public Transit program.
- Municipal Infrastructure, Municipal Capacity, Community Sustainability & Collaboration Among Municipalities
  - During 2007-08 Saskatchewan continued to build upon its existing contributions with respect to municipal infrastructure needs, improving municipal capacity, encouraging community sustainability and collaboration among municipalities. Saskatchewan remains committed to continuing to build on related initiatives over the term of the agreement. Many of the 2007-08 results of the Ministry of Municipal Affairs, as well as other provincial ministries, have contributed to this commitment, including the following:
    - The Ministry of Municipal Affairs has created the Saskatchewan Infrastructure Growth Initiative (SIGI). SIGI provides municipalities with interest subsidy grants for five years on \$300 million of municipal borrowing. The borrowing is spread over four years (2008-09 to 2011-12) at \$75 million per year. The program will assist municipalities in developing the infrastructure needed to meet the demand for serviced lots for new residential, commercial and industrial construction.

- The Ministry of Municipal Affairs teamed with municipal sector representatives and officials from the Ministry of Finance to begin negotiating a new revenue sharing deal with the municipalities that will include a percentage of the provincial government's own source revenue. The work will culminate in a new revenue sharing program for implementation in 2009-10.
- The Ministry of Municipal Affairs, in conjunction with the municipal sector and other ministries has continued working to develop a Municipal Sector Strategic Plan (MSSP) that includes a long-term, predictable and sustainable approach to infrastructure investment. The joint work plan will focus on:
  - A planned approach to infrastructure investment;
  - A policy-based approach to Revenue Sharing that leads municipalities to the development of a revenue stream tied to provincial revenues;
  - An approach that will increase inter-jurisdictional planning and co-ordination of service delivery (water, fire, emergency, waste, energy, building inspections, etc.);
  - A foundation that will increase inter-jurisdictional economic and land use planning (transportation, land development, infrastructure, etc.); and
  - A strong administrative level working relationship between municipalities and the provincial government to complement the political forums.
- The Ministry of Municipal Affairs has taken steps to consult the municipal sector on the development of a Municipal Asset Information System (MAIS). MAIS provides key information on municipal infrastructure risks, needs and pressures that will aid in establishing priority setting for municipal infrastructure investment. The joint ministry-municipal MAIS committee agreed on MAIS objectives and coordinated MAIS reporting requirements with Public Sector Accounting Board. Priority assets for MAIS and MAIS information to be collected have been identified. A request for a proposal for a feasibility study for software solutions for MAIS was issued.
- Saskatchewan provides operational funding to assist in addressing municipal infrastructure pressures and support economic development, environmental sustainability, cultural dynamism and social cohesion in our communities. During 2007-08 the following was paid out under the unconditional Revenue Sharing program:
  - \$40.7 million to rural municipalities;
  - \$67.4 million to urban municipalities; and
  - \$9.6 million to northern municipalities.

- In addition, during 2007-08, the Ministry of Municipal Affairs provided \$9 million of provincial infrastructure funding under Rural Revenue Sharing to support sustainable rural municipal infrastructure and economic development, including:
  - \$4.2 million was paid to 128 rural municipalities, 22 towns, six villages and one Indian Band for the maintenance of rural municipal primary weight corridors and associated sign installation;
  - \$4.7 million was paid to 37 rural municipalities for bridges and heavy haul and high volume roads;
  - \$104,000 was paid to undertake traffic counting in rural municipalities; and
  - \$29,000 was paid to one municipality was paid to one municipality under the Communities in Transition Program.
  
- During 2007-08, the Ministry of Municipal Affairs paid \$37.1 million in provincial infrastructure funding to match federal funding under the Municipal Rural Infrastructure Fund (MRIF), the Canada Saskatchewan Infrastructure Program (CSIP), the Canada Strategic Infrastructure Fund (CSIF), and Urban Development Agreements to support priority sustainable municipal infrastructure projects and economic development, including:
  - \$4.7 million paid to 20 municipalities under the CSIP for 19 water and sewer projects, one local road project and one solid waste project;
  - \$25.3 million to 119 municipalities under MRIF for 72 water and sewer projects, 55 local roads, three recreation projects, two solid waste projects, one energy efficiency and one capacity building project;
  - \$528,000 under the Urban Development Agreements for approved projects in Regina and Saskatoon; and
  - \$4.8 million under CSIF to Saskatoon for the completion of its South Downtown Redevelopment Project. An additional \$1.8 million was paid to the Rural Municipality (RM) of North Qu'Appelle to address sewage lagoon pressures.

- Many initiatives undertaken by other provincial ministries also made substantial progress respecting municipal infrastructure needs and community sustainability. For example, the Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure implemented a strategic approach to infrastructure

investment in the province during 2007-08 to ensure continued economic growth and a secure future. Further details on this Ministry's progress can be found at:

- Also, the Ministry of Tourism, Parks, Culture and Sport's Building Communities Program provided capital funding for new construction, sustainable development and rehabilitation of community-created recreational and cultural infrastructure. In 2007-08, the Ministry approved 27 Building Communities Program Projects representing a total provincial commitment of \$81.5 million. An additional \$2 million was allocated for infrastructure projects in Northern Saskatchewan. Further details on this Ministry's progress can be found at:

- Incrementality - Provincial and Municipal Funding
  - With respect to the requirement for the federal funding to be incremental to Saskatchewan's infrastructure funding and incremental to infrastructure expenditures by municipalities, the New Deal Secretariat will continue to gather information to facilitate an assessment of the incremental spending during the period of 2005-06 to 2009-10 as required under the Gas Tax Agreement and the Public Transit Agreement.

## **Infrastructure Investment Plans**

736 IIPs were approved under the Gas Tax Program during the period of August 23, 2005 (program inception) to March 31, 2008 representing 515 municipalities. Municipalities estimate that gas tax funds of \$77.7 million will be invested in these 736 IIPs which have a total cost of \$254 million. A listing of these eligible projects approved for funding (including the location, investment category, amount and identity of all sources of funding, nature of the investment and expected environmental outcomes) is included in Appendix A. A listing of the names of the municipalities with IIPs approved is included in Appendix B.



From August 23, 2005 to March 31, 2008, there were 736 IIPs approved in the following categories: 233 Roads and Bridges; 194 Water; 157 Community Energy; 67 Solid Waste; 75 Wastewater; 9 Capacity Building; and 1 Public Transit.

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## 1. Scope of the Agreement on the Transfer of Federal Gas Tax Revenues

On August 23, 2005, Saskatchewan Government Relations, now the Saskatchewan Ministry of Municipal Affairs (“Saskatchewan”) and Infrastructure and Communities Canada (“Canada”) executed the Canada-Saskatchewan Agreement on the Transfer Of Federal Gas Tax Revenues Under the New Deal for Cities and Communities 2005 - 2015 (the “Agreement”). The Agreement was subsequently amended on January 12, 2007 and September 4, 2008.

The Agreement provides a joint framework for the transfer of funds from Canada to Saskatchewan for administration and subsequent allocation to municipalities for the purpose of investment in environmentally sustainable municipal infrastructure and municipal capacity building projects.

The Agreement further provides that Saskatchewan agrees to pay funding to municipalities solely for eligible projects, as described in Schedule A of the Agreement, and solely for the purpose of paying eligible costs as described in Schedule B of the Agreement and that funding may be used for the purpose of paying all administration costs of Saskatchewan, as provided for in the Agreement.

For the purposes of the Annual Allocation and Expenditure Statement, Saskatchewan has defined the material provisions of the Agreement as follows:

- Section 3.2 – Commitments by the Government of Saskatchewan
- Section 5.3 – Payments - Limit on Use of Canada’s Funds
- Section 6 – Allocations to Municipalities, Use of Funds, and Delivery Mechanism
- Section 7.1 – Reporting, Audits and Evaluation - Reporting
- Section 7.2 – Reporting, Audits and Evaluation - Audits

## 2. Interest earned

The annual allocation provided by Canada to Saskatchewan is held by Saskatchewan pending future payments in accordance with the Agreement. Saskatchewan has an arrangement with the Saskatchewan Ministry of Finance respecting the receipt, disbursement and amounts held for future payments to municipalities.

Saskatchewan has calculated interest earned using the Province of Saskatchewan’s thirty day borrowing rate. Interest earned on amounts held by Saskatchewan shall be used only for the purpose of making payments to municipalities or for paying administrative costs incurred by Saskatchewan.

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### **3. Administrative costs**

Under the terms of the Agreement, the annual allocation has been used to pay for administrative costs incurred by Saskatchewan. All administrative costs incurred during the year ending March 31, 2008, are in accordance with a business case, dated September 1, 2005, approved by Canada. In addition, the administration costs regarding the federal public transit funding provided pursuant to the Canada-Saskatchewan Agreement on the Transfer of Funds for Public Transit 2005 - 2010 are included as agreed to by Canada.

### **4. Reporting of municipality financial information**

Schedule D of the Agreement states that in the case of municipalities with a year-end other than March 31<sup>st</sup>, the Annual Allocation and Expenditure Statement may include information in respect of eligible projects related to that municipality to the year-end of that municipality. All municipalities in Saskatchewan have a December 31<sup>st</sup> year-end. As a result, the Annual Allocation and Expenditure Statement reports amounts held by municipalities to be expended on eligible costs and amounts expended by municipalities on eligible costs as at and for the year ending December 31, 2007.

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## 1. Scope of the Agreement on the Transfer of Funds for Public Transit

On March 31, 2006, Saskatchewan Government Relations, now the Saskatchewan Ministry of Municipal Affairs (“Saskatchewan”) and Transport, Infrastructure and Communities Canada (“Canada”) executed the Canada-Saskatchewan Agreement on the Transfer of Funds for Public Transit 2005 - 2010 (the “Agreement”).

The Agreement provides a joint framework for the transfer of funds from Canada to Saskatchewan for investment in public transit infrastructure.

The Agreement further provides that Saskatchewan agrees to pay funding to eligible recipients solely for eligible projects, as described in Schedule A of the Agreement, and solely for the purpose of paying eligible costs as described in Schedule B of the Agreement.

For the purposes of the Annual Funding and Expenditure Statement, Saskatchewan has defined the material provisions of the Agreement as follows:

- Section 4.2 – Saskatchewan Commitments
- Section 6.4 – Limit on Canada’s Financial Commitments
- Section 7 – Allocation to Eligible Recipients, Delivery Mechanism, and Use of Funds
- Section 8.1 – Reporting
- Section 8.2 – Audits

In addition, the federal government established a Public Transit Capital Trust (the “Trust”) to provide supplementary public transit funding to provinces and territories to support capital investment in public transit. The federal government issued Public Transit Capital Trust Operating Principles (the “Operating Principles”) to govern the use of the funding. Accordingly, the Annual Funding and Expenditure Statement includes the receipt of funding by Saskatchewan and expenditures to the municipalities in accordance with the above noted Operating Principles.

## 2. Reporting of eligible recipient financial information

Schedule D of the Agreement states that in the case of eligible recipients with a year-end other than March 31<sup>st</sup>, the Annual Funding and Expenditure Statement may include information in respect of eligible projects related to that eligible recipient to the year-end of that eligible recipient. All eligible recipients in Saskatchewan have a December 31<sup>st</sup> year-end. As a result, the Annual Funding and Expenditure Statement reports amounts held by eligible recipients to be expended on eligible costs and amounts claimed by eligible recipients on eligible costs as at and for the year ending December 31, 2007.
