CHAPTER 119

An Act to provide for Exemption from Taxation of Certain Property of Saskatoon Bible College, of Saskatoon, Saskatchewan

(Assented to March 30, 1945)

Preamble

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying for an Act of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan to provide for permanent exemption of the property hereinafter mentioned from all taxes, rates, levies and assessment of every nature and kind save and except special assessment taxes under Part XII of *The City Act*; and

Whereas the City of Saskatoon has by resolution consented to such exemption; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Exemption from taxation

1 The real property of Saskatoon Bible College, of Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, being lots 1 and 2 and parts of lots 3 to 6 inclusive not taken for right of way of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company, all in block 15, in the City of Saskatoon, according to a plan of record in the land titles office for the Saskatoon Land Registration District as No. D.J. (G.582), and all personal property of the college now or hereafter acquired, shall, while used for the purposes of the college, being for instruction of youth in the Holy Scriptures or for seminary purposes, and for no other purpose, be exempt from all taxes, rates, levies and assessment of every nature and kind save and except special assessment taxes under Part XII of *The City Act*.
