CHAPTER 188

An Act to provide for the Safety of Electrical Workers

Short title

1 This Act may be cited as *The Electrical Workers' Protection Act*.

Regulations

2 The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations governing the construction, maintenance and use of electric wires, wiring apparatus and appliances, poles, cables and fixtures for electric light, heat or power, telegraph, telephone or other purposes.

Publishing

3 Every order in council containing such regulations shall fix the date upon which the regulations shall come into force, and such regulations shall be published in two consecutive issues of *The Saskatchewan Gazette* prior to such date.
