CHAPTER 117

An Act for the Creation of Scholarships for Canadian Students in Paris

Short title

1 This Act may be cited as *The War Memorial Scholarships Act*.

Establishment of scholarships

2 The Lieutenant Governor in Council is hereby authorised to grant annually three scholarships of \$1,200 each to such students or teachers, usually resident in Saskatchewan, as he may designate, for the purpose of assisting them to follow post-graduate courses of study in the city of Paris, France.

Conditions

3 Such scholarships shall be granted on such terms and conditions and under such regulations as may be prescribed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, and the money required for the purpose shall be chargeable to and payable out of the consolidated fund.
