The big game draw is part of the automated Hunting, Angling and Trapping Licence (HAL) system.

All processes associated with the big game draw are now handled through HAL including:

- submitting applications;
- reviewing and updating applications;
- checking pool status history; and
- purchasing licences.

If you are successful in the big game draw, the appropriate licence will be available for purchase on your account. You simply select the licences you want to purchase and complete the transaction. Remember, if purchasing through your HAL web account you need to acquire big game seals ahead of time, which can be ordered at no charge anytime, and enter your big game seal number to complete your purchase.

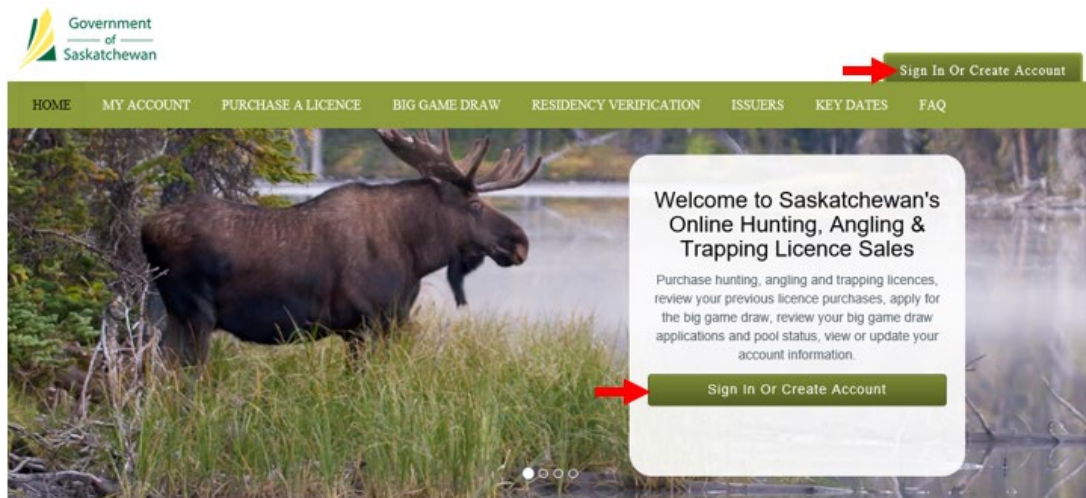

Step 1 – Make sure you have an account in the Hunting, Angling and Trapping Licence (HAL) system.

Before you can apply for the Saskatchewan resident big game draw, you must have a HAL number (HAL ID). Your HAL number is a permanent 9-digit assigned number that can be used to purchase and apply for all future Saskatchewan hunting, angling and trapping licences. If you have previously purchased a hunting, angling or trapping licence, or have applied for the big game draw since 2013, you already have a HAL number.

If you do not remember your HAL number and cannot access your account online, call 1-855-848-4773 for assistance. Do not create another account. Your HAL number also appears on all previously printed licences that were purchased through the online licence service. If you do not have an existing HAL number and need to have an account created, please visit saskatchewan.ca/hunting to access a step-by-step guide on how to create an account online.

To submit an application, you will need to access your HAL account online. If you have not previously accessed your account online, click the **Sign In** option at the top right corner of the screen and then select **Look up your profile**. You will be prompted to enter a password and must also provide an email address. Receipts and important notifications will be sent to the email address provided, and if you forget your password you can reset it using your email address. Once you have set your password you can click the **Sign In** option and enter your password the next time you need to sign into your account.



Step 2 – Read all the updated information on the Saskatchewan Resident Big Game Draw including new changes, available hunts, season dates and quotas.

The Saskatchewan Resident Big Game Draw Supplement and further information such as previous years' draw results and an overview of the big game draw process is available from this page. some zones the prevalence rate of Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) is high. If this is an important consideration for you, please visit the [Government of Saskatchewan CWD page](#) for information on CWD in Saskatchewan.

Make sure that you read the current [Saskatchewan Resident Big Game Draw Supplement](#) for information about the draw, including available hunts, season dates and quotas. Hunts often correspond to a wildlife management zone (WMZ) but be aware that some hunts allow a drawn hunter to hunt in more than one WMZ (combined WMZs), only in a portion of a WMZ, in a provincial park only, or in a Wildlife Management Unit only (e.g. Fort a la Corne Wildlife Management Unit). There may also be both an either-sex and an antlerless only hunt available for the same area. You should also view the newest [Wildlife Management Zone Map](#) to familiarize yourself with recent updates to WMZ boundaries and assist you with selecting hunts on your application.

Two new changes were implemented to the priority pool structure beginning with the 2018 big game draw.

1. A 'Legacy' priority pool was added to provide top priority in the draw for long-time unsuccessful applicants. Hunters who qualify for 'Legacy' pool include those who have applied 10 or more consecutive years (including zone 99 applications) with 'Super A' pool status without having been successfully drawn. Hunters who have previously applied can check their pool status, including the number of years in 'Super A' that count towards reaching the 'Legacy' pool, by visiting the 'My Account' section through their HAL account.
2. An additional 'D' was added as the lowest priority pool and will extend the time period for which a drawn applicant will return to the 'Super A' pool, thereby reducing the number of applicants in 'Super A'. All drawn hunters will move to 'D' pool for the following year, and all new applicants for a species are assigned 'D' pool status.

Additionally, hunters who are drawn for three or more draw species may decline awarded licence(s) and maintain their pool status. However, they must keep the awarded licence(s) for at least two species (i.e. a hunter drawn for three species may decline awarded licences for one species only, a hunter drawn for four species may decline awarded licences for one or two species, and so on). All eligible hunters wishing to decline awarded licences must notify the Ministry of Environment by email at centre.inquiry@gov.sk.ca by July 31. No awarded draw licences can be declined past this date.

Step 3 – Gather applicant information. Ensure all applicants for your big game draw application have a HAL number and have reviewed all of the big game draw information for the current year.

To apply for the Saskatchewan resident big game draw you will need:

1. Your HAL number (HAL ID).
2. HAL number and date of birth of all members of your hunting party. If you are planning to apply as a group for any species, this information will be required to add members to your application.

3. The Saskatchewan Resident Big Game Draw Supplement – this document contains information about big game draw seasons, quotas and available hunts to assist you with making hunt choices.
4. A computer or other device with internet access.
5. A Visa or MasterCard.
6. All applicants of the big game draw must be eligible, including having completed a Firearm Safety/Hunter Education course.
7. If you are adding any members to your application that qualify for Saskatchewan resident hunting privileges as a member of the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF), make sure they have added their regimental number to their account. This must be done before submitting the application – you do not enter the regimental number on the application.



Applications can be submitted from May 1 to midnight, May 25. Non-residents (of Canada) are not eligible for the big game draw and must use the services of a licensed outfitter to hunt big game in Saskatchewan. Canadian residents who are not Saskatchewan residents may apply for white-tailed deer but are not eligible for other species. To access the Saskatchewan's online licence system go to saskatchewanlicences.active.com. To apply, sign into your HAL account and select **Purchase a Licence** from the menu options at the top of the page and select **Big Game Draw** from the sub-menu.


Step 4 – Select the big game species you wish to apply for.

Only applications you are eligible for will display. If you have already submitted an application for a species, it will not display as an available option. When selecting a species, you can only select one species at a time. Your choices are moose, elk, mule deer, pronghorn, antlerless mule deer and youth draw (antlerless mule deer). To

apply for the youth draw, hunters must be 12 to 15 years of age at the time of application. If you are applying for moose or elk, be aware that there are both antlerless and either-sex hunts available for some wildlife management zones (WMZs). For elk and moose you cannot apply for either-sex and antlerless separately, and you have only one pool status.

Big Game Draw Terms and Conditions

! Please read and accept the following terms and conditions before applying for or modifying any big game draw applications.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be Saskatchewan residents at the time of application.
 - The applicant must be a Canadian citizen or Canadian resident for the 12 month period prior to applying, must have resided in Saskatchewan for at least three months immediately prior to applying, and must possess a valid Saskatchewan Health Services Card as proof of residence (exception is for members of a regular force of the Canadian Armed Forces who were a Saskatchewan resident at the time of recruitment or deployment, in which case they must have provided their regimental number on their HAL account prior to applying).
- Each applicant must comply with [The Firearm Safety/Hunter Education Regulations](#). Note that there are separate federal firearm requirements. A federal Possession and Acquisition Licence (PAL) does not exempt a person born after January 1, 1971 from requiring completion of firearm safety/hunter education course, prior to applying.
- Hunters who are suspended from hunting and trapping may not submit big game draw applications, including zone 99 applications. All applications with a suspended group member will be rejected.
- Applicants must be at least 12 years of age at the time of application. Only persons 12 to 15 years of age may apply for the youth draw.
- All applications are reviewed prior to the draw. Applications containing false or misleading information will be rejected and excluded from the draw. Ensure that all information entered onto the application is accurate.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- The deadline to apply is midnight, May 25.
- The HAL ID and date of birth must be entered for each group member of the application.
- Licences will not be mailed to successful applicants. All applicants are responsible for looking up their draw result. For successfully drawn applications, each group member is responsible for purchasing their awarded licence through the automated licensing system (HAL).
- For elk and moose, you may select both either-sex and antlerless hunt choices on a single application. However, keep in mind that you only have one pool status for each species.
- Each hunter may submit one application per species only. If a person submits more than one application for a species, all of his or her applications will be rejected, including all group members. Either-sex and antlerless mule deer are considered separate species for the purposes of the big game draw. Youth ages 12-15 may also submit a youth draw application in addition to an antlerless mule deer application, but they can only be drawn for one.
- Once drawn, hunters cannot forfeit or transfer their awarded licence. All drawn applicants are ineligible for a regular licence of the same species and will be moved to 'C' pool for the following year, regardless of whether or not the awarded licence is purchased.
- A valid Visa or MasterCard is required. There is a \$6.00 application non-refundable application fee for each application.
- Any email addresses included on group member's HAL accounts may be used to send important notifications regarding seasons and regulations, and for the purposes of surveying hunters on hunting activity and harvest.

TIPS

- Make sure you review the [2017 Saskatchewan Resident Big Game Draw Supplement](#) prior to applying. The supplement contains important information including new changes. Do not assume that available hunts, quotas, season dates and bag limits are the same as last year.
- Always double check your application(s) prior to the May 25 deadline; no changes can be made once the deadline has passed. You may review your application details by visiting My Account at any time. The group leader (person who submits the application) may also make changes to the application prior to the deadline.
- Visit the [big game draw page](#) for additional information to assist you with selecting hunt choices, such as previous years draw and hunter harvest survey results.
- The application is placed into the priority pool of the group member with the lowest pool status. If applying as a group, make sure you know each member's pool status.
- For elk and moose, you may select both either-sex and antlerless hunt choices on a single application. However, keep in mind that you have only one pool status for each species. Selecting more hunt choices (maximum of 6) and less popular hunts will increase your chances of being drawn, but only select hunts you are willing to be drawn for as you will move to 'C' pool if your application is drawn.

By clicking on 'Accept and Proceed' you accept the above Terms and Conditions on behalf of yourself and all group members added to your application(s) for all big game draw applications submitted.

Step 6 – Select your hunt choices.

You may select from one to six hunt choices. During the draw, preference will be given to your selections in the order specified (i.e. 1st choice has preference over 2nd choice, 2nd choice has preference over 3rd choice, and so on). You cannot select the same hunt more than once. Make sure that you are aware of the zone boundaries and you have selected the correct hunt(s) before proceeding. Further information about the hunt is available by clicking on the info button. Remember, hunt codes that end with an “A” are for antlerless only seasons. If you do not wish to select hunts for antlerless only seasons, you can filter for either-sex or antlerless only seasons by selecting the filter option under Species Sub-Type. Also be aware of weapon types, some hunts are archery only.

Once you have selected all of the hunt choices for this application, click the submit button at the bottom of your selection list.

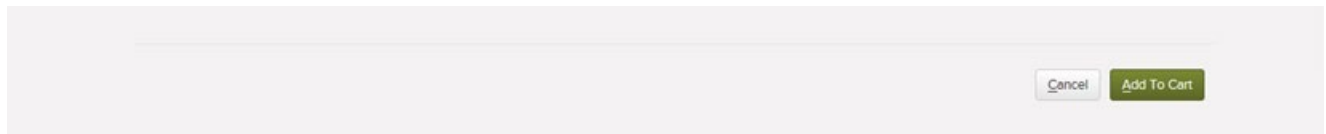




