1 Power of Provincial Treasurer to purchase lands

CHAPTER 65

An Act to enable the Provincial Treasurer to purchase Certain Lands

Power of Provincial Treasurer to purchase lands

1 Where land has been charged with repayment of the amount of an advance made by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, the Minister of Municipal Affairs or the Minister of Agriculture pursuant to:

- (a) *The Local Improvements Act*, chapter 90 of *The Revised Statutes of Saskatchewan, 1920*;
- (b) *The Local Improvement Districts Act* or any former *Local Improvement Districts Act*; or
- (c) *The Local Improvement Districts Relief Act* or any former *Local Improvement Districts Relief Act*;

and proceedings have been taken for foreclosure or for sale of the land by a person having a previous charge against “the land, then, for the protection of such advance, the Provincial Treasurer, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, may out of moneys in the consolidated fund purchase the lands so charged.
