

MINISTER'S ORDER

Under The Oil and Gas Conservation Act

Glen Ewen/Oxbow Area Associated Gas Conservation

Effective immediately all new and existing oil and gas operations within the area specified below shall comply with section 51(2) and (3) of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Regulations, 2012*:

Lands West of the First Meridian:

In Townships 2 to 4, Range 34: All Sections;


Lands West of the Second Meridian:

In Townships 2 to 4, Ranges 1 to 3: All Sections.

All new oil and gas wells or facilities licensed after January 1, 2015 in the specified area may no longer apply the exemptions provided under the *Saskatchewan Upstream Petroleum Industry Associated Gas Conservation Directive S-10*, with respect to the economic, air emission and associated gas volume flaring and venting exemptions.

All existing oil and gas wells or facilities licensed after July 1, 2012 in the specified area may no longer apply the exemptions provided under the *Saskatchewan Upstream Petroleum Industry Associated Gas Conservation Directive S-10*, with respect to the economic, air emission and associated gas volume flaring and venting exemptions, unless the economic analysis specified in the Directive is submitted to the Ministry of the Economy by February 27, 2015.
