



NOTICE OF REOPENING

CROWN RESERVATION NO. 558

The Crown Minerals Act

Whereas:

- (a) Crown Reservation No. 558 was established on November 25, 1949 under the authority of *The Mineral Resources Act, 1931* to withdraw from dispositioning all Crown sand, gravel and stone rights in the area near the future site of the Gardiner Dam;
- (b) *The Crown Minerals Act* does not consider sand and gravel to be “minerals”;

Notice is therefore given that pursuant to section 21.1 of *The Crown Minerals Act*, the Minister’s Order dated November 25, 1949 establishing Crown Reservation No. 558, which comprises the following lands, is hereby rescinded on the date shown below:

Township 26, Range 6, West of the 3rd Meridian

All of Section 30 and the West half of Section 31

Township 26, Range 7, West of the 3rd Meridian

The Northeast quarter of Section 23, the North half of Section 24, All of Section 25, the Northeast quarter of Section 26, the Northeast quarter of Section 27, the East half of the Southwest quarter and the Southeast quarter of Section 34, the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 34, all of Section 35, all of Section 36

Township 27, Range 7, West of the Third Meridian

The South half of Section 1, and the Southeast quarter of Section 2.
