

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

August 2014

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering August 10th to 16th 2014, there were 572,400 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is a decrease of 400 from July 2014 but 7,500 more than the number employed in August 2013.

Agricultural employment was 49,600 persons in August 2014, up 2,800 from the July 2014 level and 4,700 more than the August 2013 agricultural employment level of 44,900. Non-agricultural employment was 522,800 persons in August 2014. This is a decrease of 3,200 from the July 2014 non-agriculture employment level of 526,000 but 2,800 more than August 2013.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for August 2014 was 5.2 percent. This is an increase of 1.6 percentage points from the July 2014 rate of 3.6 percent and 0.2 percentage points higher than the August 2013 level of 5.0 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force increased by 10,200 to 604,100 persons in August 2014 from 593,900 persons in July 2014. This is 9,300 more than the August 2013 labour force of 594,800 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate rose 1.1 percentage points to 71.5 percent in August 2014 from 70.4 percent in July 2014. The August 2013 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 71.8 percent.

There were 31,700 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during August 2014. This is an increase of 10,600 from July 2014 and is 1,800 more than the number unemployed in August 2013.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 566,700 persons employed in Saskatchewan in August 2014, up 200 from the July 2014 level of 566,500 and is up 8,100 from the August 2013 employment level of 558,600 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for August 2014 was 4.2 percent. This is an increase of 1.0 percentage points from the July 2014 rate of 3.2 percent but the same as the August 2013 rate of 4.2 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment decreased by 58,500 persons in August 2014 to 18,098,900 persons from 18,157,400 persons in July 2014. In August 2013, there were 18,027,600 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate increased 0.2 percentage points in August 2014 to 7.5 percent from the July 2014 level of 7.3 percent. In August 2013, Canada's unemployment rate was 7.6 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 7.0 percent in August 2014. This is the same as July 2014 but 0.1 percentage points lower than the August 2013 level of 7.1 percent.
