

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

July 2011

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey for the week ended July 16, 2011, there were 532,600 persons employed in Saskatchewan during July 2011, a decrease of 4,600 from June 2011 but 2,200 more than the number employed in July 2010.

Agricultural employment was 41,500 persons in July 2011, up 2,100 from the June 2011 level but 2,200 less than the July 2010 agricultural employment level of 43,700. Non-agricultural employment was 491,100 persons in July 2011. This is a decrease of 6,700 from the June 2011 non-agriculture employment level of 497,800 but 4,400 more than July 2010.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for July 2011 was 5.2 percent. This is an increase of 0.9 percentage points from the June 2011 rate of 4.3 percent but 0.2 percentage points lower than the July 2010 level of 5.4 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force increased by 1,000 to 562,100 persons in July 2011 from 561,100 persons in June 2011. This is 1,200 more than the July 2010 labour force of 560,900 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate for July 2011 was 70.2 percent, which is unchanged from June 2011. The July 2010 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 70.8 percent.

There were 29,500 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during July 2011. This is an increase of 5,600 from June 2011 but is 1,000 less than the number unemployed in July 2010.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 526,800 persons employed in Saskatchewan in July 2011, up 1,600 from the June 2011 level of 525,200 and is up 2,000 from the July 2010 employment level of 524,800 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for July 2011 was 4.9 percent. This is unchanged from June 2011 but 0.2 percentage points lower than the July 2010 rate of 5.1 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment decreased by 61,100 persons in July 2011 to 17,632,200 persons from 17,693,300 persons in June 2011. In July 2010, there were 17,378,300 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate increased 0.6 percentage points in July 2011 to 7.6 percent from the June 2011 level of 7.0 percent. In July 2010, Canada's unemployment rate was 8.3 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 7.2 percent in July 2011. This is 0.2 percentage points lower than June 2011 and 0.8 percentage points lower than the July 2010 level of 8.0 percent.
