

# Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

July 2017

## UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering July 9<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017, there were 574,400 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is a decrease of 5,400 from June 2017 and 1,700 less than the number employed in July 2016.

Agricultural employment was 38,900 persons in July 2017, up 800 from the June 2017 level but 3,800 less than the July 2016 agricultural employment level of 42,700. Non-agricultural employment was 535,500 persons in July 2017. This is a decrease of 6,200 from the June 2017 non-agriculture employment level of 541,700 but 2,100 more than July 2016.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for July 2017 was 6.6 percent. This is an increase of 0.8 percentage points from the June 2017 rate of 5.8 percent and 0.3 percentage points higher than the July 2016 level of 6.3 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force decreased by 500 to 615,000 persons in July 2017 from 615,500 persons in June 2017. This is 200 more than the July 2016 labour force of 614,800 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate fell 0.1 percentage points to 70.1 percent in July 2017 from 70.2 percent in June 2017. The July 2016 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 70.7 percent.

There were 40,600 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during July 2017. This is an increase of 4,900 from June 2017 and is 2,000 more than the number unemployed in July 2016.

## SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 568,000 persons employed in Saskatchewan in July 2017, down 400 from the June 2017 level of 568,400 and is down 1,400 from the July 2016 employment level of 569,400 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for July 2017 was 6.6 percent. This is an increase of 0.1 percentage points from the June 2017 rate of 6.5 percent and 0.3 percentage points higher than the July 2016 rate of 6.3 percent.

## CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment decreased by 70,500 persons in July 2017 to 18,698,800 persons from 18,769,300 persons in June 2017. In July 2016, there were 18,301,600 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate increased 0.5 percentage points in July 2017 to 6.5 percent from the June 2017 level of 6.0 percent. In July 2016, Canada's unemployment rate was 7.2 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 6.3 percent in July 2017. This is 0.2 percentage points lower than June 2017 and 0.7 percentage points lower than the July 2016 level of 7.0 percent.
