Extension: Shadow Billing for IRIS Non-compliance Penalty Assessment Program Continues Until Early Autumn – 2018:

Changes to *The Oil and Gas Conservation Regulation*, 2012, which are intended to fully-enable IRIS's non-compliance penalty assessment program, are expected to be complete for enforcement in the near future.

The Government of Saskatchewan has encountered a number of issues related to IRIS obligations that require fixes. These fixes will be applied as soon as possible but may take a few IRIS release cycles to complete. As a result, the Government of Saskatchewan is extending the shadow-billing period for the non-compliance penalty assessment program for unfulfilled oil and gas well data submission obligations in IRIS until early autumn 2018.

Shadow-billing will continue during this period. In the meantime, industry is encouraged to continue working toward fulfilling any outstanding IRIS obligations to avoid financial penalties when the shadow-billing period ends.
