

MINISTER'S ORDER

Under *The Crown Minerals Act*

Province of Saskatchewan – Suspension of the Oil and Gas Tenure Registry
December 4, 2018

WHEREAS:

- a) On Tuesday, December 4, 2018, a major power outage affected much of Saskatchewan;
- b) The power outage affected the ability of interested parties to access the Oil and Gas Tenure Registry to submit bids on parcels offered in the December 4, 2018, Public Offering of Crown Dispositions for Petroleum and Natural Gas, Oil Sands or Oil Shale Rights (Public Notice 386) that was scheduled to accept bids until 12:00:00 PM, Central Standard Time on December 4, 2018; and
- c) The Minister has reviewed the circumstances of the power outage and determined that interested parties affected by outage were disadvantaged in regards to this unforeseen circumstance.

NOW THEREFORE, and in accordance with section 27.5 of *The Crown Minerals Act*, I do hereby Order the suspension of the public offering bid function necessary for acquiring oil and gas dispositions in the Oil and Gas Tenure Registry for Public Notice 386 at 11:59:00 AM Central Standard Time on December 4, 2018, subject to the following terms:

- 1) The public offering bid function in the Oil and Gas Tenure Registry for Public Notice 386 will recommence operation at 11:00:00 AM on December 5, 2018, until 12:00:00 PM on December 5, 2018.
